Notice of Appeal/Notice of Cross Appeal – Mandatory Requirements and Check/Return Form

A. Filing Fee (Rule 14.89 – civil only)

The notice of appeal (civil only) has not been filed because a \$600.00 filing fee is required. Payment may be made by cash, Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Interac, certified cheque or money order payable to the “Government of Alberta”. In compliance with Credit Card Industry Standards, credit card payments over the phone or via fax or email cannot be accepted.

C. Where to File (Rule 14.8(5))

The notice of appeal has been filed with a(n)
Select either Edmonton or Calgary appeal number and all subsequent documents must be filed in
Select either Edmonton or Calgary.

B. Content (Rules 14.12, 14.87 and 16.7)

Form AP-1 is the prescribed form for a civil notice of appeal and Form AP-2 is the prescribed form for a notice of cross appeal. The prescribed forms for criminal notices of appeal are Form CRA-A (if the appellant is self-represented) and Form CRA-B (for all other appeals).
